## A Time-Driven Prayer Guide for the Sunday Worship Service

10:30-10:35 – Take this time to settle yourself in to prayer. Read a Psalm or two (ex. Psalm 84, 100). Use the Hymnal to sing a song. Write down any distractions that might be on your mind (things to do, who to speak with, etc.)

10:35-10:40 – Spend time preparing your own heart to pray through confession of sin. Suggested scriptures: 1 John 1:9; Psalm 51, 66, 78, 86).

10:40-10:50 – Pray for the church members and guests. Pray for their spiritual growth, marriages, financial struggle, addictions, holiness and other items that come to mind.

**10:50-11:00** – Pray for the ministries of the church including the time of offering (remember, giving reveals the heart). Pray for the ministry leaders.

11:00-11:15 – Pray for the Pastor as he teaches.

**11:15-11:30** – Pray for any submitted prayer requests. If you are aware of updates, please pass them along to the Pastor or the church office.

11:30-11:40 – Pray for the move of God as people respond to the message. Pray for salvations, rededications, call to ministry and missions, membership, etc.

11:40-11:45 - Use the back journal to write down anything you felt God placing upon your heart.
